(1) You **must** have made application to the Teacher Ed Program at this point in order to be allowed to pass Explorations In Education. **BME students 1.** All applicants *must* report an ACT score; any applicant has not previously taken the ACT will need to do so. **2.** If an applicant has already taken the ACT but does not meet the minimum requirement of 24, they will need to retake the ACT or petition to the Committee for Admission to and Retention in Teacher Education (CARTE) to be allowed to meet the requirement using other basic skills testing methods, such as C-Base and Core.**3.** These new requirements apply only to the students who apply for Teacher Education this semester (fall 2015), and all applicants thereafter.

(2) You **must** make sure that you have taken and passed ENGL 101-English Composition, ENGL 299 – Intro to Research Writing, COMM 207- Speech, and your Math requirement before you enter your Junior Year so that you can enter the Teacher Education Sequence. MUSIC 121 Intro to Music Lit is one of your Writing to Learn courses and Music\*321 History of Music, fulfills the second writing to learn requirement. (3) MUSIC 121 MUSIC Literature counts as a General Ed. requirement.

(4) You will be required to take your **piano proficiency** at the end of your sophomore spring semester. Please see “Student Handbook.”
